Funding Criteria



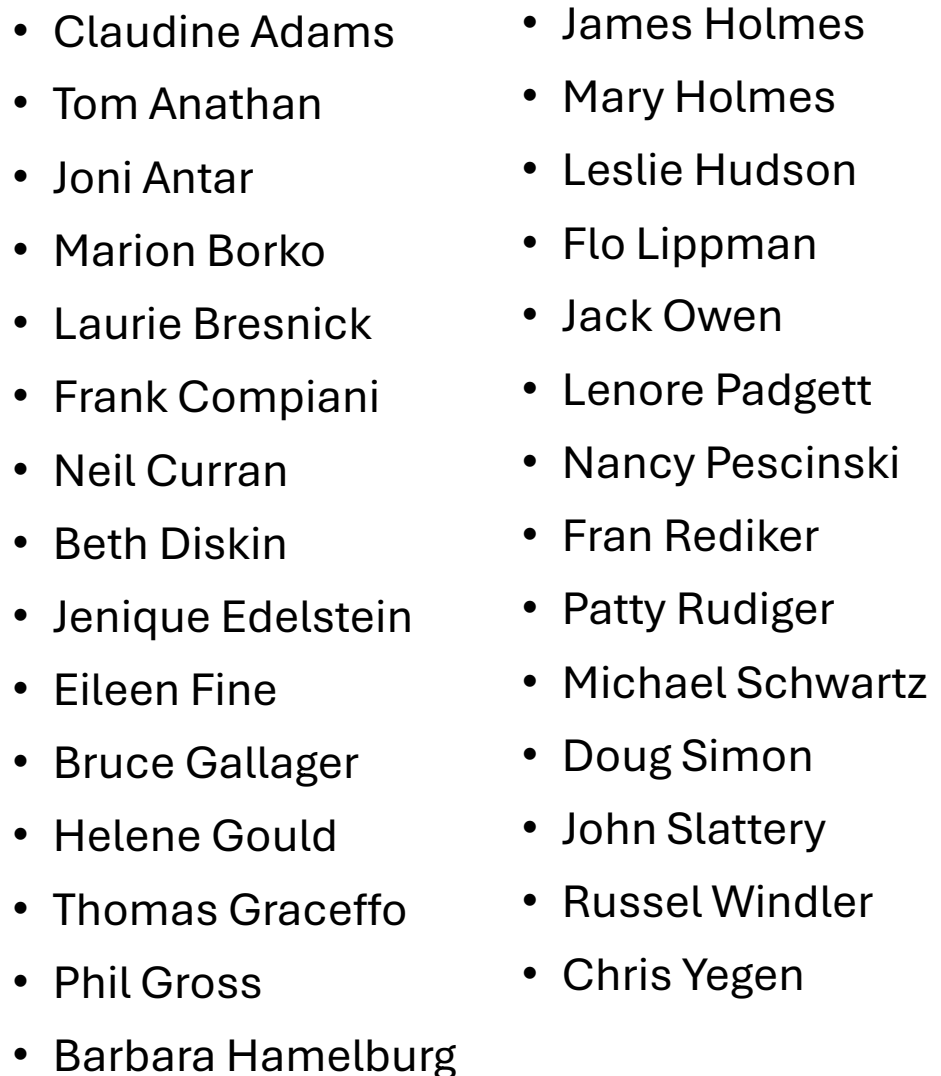
- Programs must address one of the following:

To ensure the immediate availability of cost-effective mental health interventions to serve the most in need Palm Beach County residents impacted by trauma related experiences.

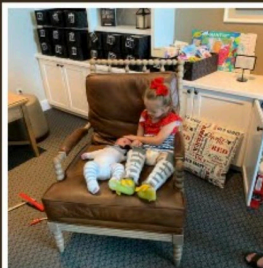


Feed The Hungry Pantry

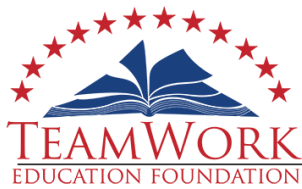


Quantum House is a caring and supportive home that lessens the burden for families whose children are receiving treatment in Palm Beach County for a serious medical condition.

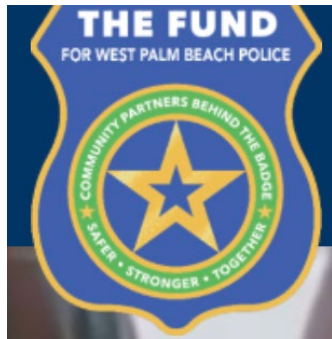




TeamWork was established in 2012 with an unwavering commitment to help the students of Palm Beach County.
